# TOURNAMENT BAD BEAT

Every Day

## PROGRESSIVE JACKPOT



**RULES:**

1. A jackpot fee of \$1 will be taken from the house fee, per tournament entry, of all regularly scheduled tournaments.
2. Any tournaments from which a jackpot donation is taken will be eligible for the jackpot.
3. Jackpot totals will be updated and posted at 9am daily.
4. To be eligible: Four deuces or a better hand loses to a higher ranked hand. The winning and losing hands must use both hole cards. Any four-of-a-kind must be made from a pocket pair.
5. Players holding any qualifying hands must use both cards which are dealt face down to them (hole cards) combine with three community board cards.
6. All qualifying hands are eligible to share in the jackpot, even if two or three losing hands meet qualifications (e.g., if the final board reads 7h 8h 9h 8s 9s and J-10h, 5-6h, 8c-8d, and 9c-9d were shown at the end of the hand, all hands would qualify).
7. Payouts are as follows:
  - a. When one losing hand is eligible: Losing hand 70%, Winning hand 30%
  - b. When two losing hands are eligible: Best losing hand 50%, 2nd best losing hand 30%, Winning hand 20%.
  - c. When three losing hands are eligible: Best losing hand 45%, 2nd best losing hand 25%, 3rd best losing hand 15%, Winning hand 15%.
8. Players must play their hands independently. Any discussion of the jackpot during the play of the hand may void qualification for the prize. If any player, whether directly or indirectly involved in the hand, passes information or instructs another player on how to act or reveals his/her hand to other players, the Bad Beat will be disqualified.
9. Management reserves the right to verify eligibility of all qualifying hands. There will be no recourse if the cards are mucked before surveillance is able to verify the hands and the community cards. Poker Management will not be permitted to reconstruct the hands in any way.
10. A fouled deck, switched cards, unverifiable hand, or miss deals negate the award of the Tournament Bad Beat Jackpot. Fouled deck is defined as any deck that is not one complete standard unmarked deck of 52 cards. A verifiable hand is defined as when both of the player's down cards are turned face up on the table so that both cards are visible to the dealer and all players on the table. If at any time the player's cards leave the table, the hand is unverifiable and the bad beat is voided.

**GENERAL PROMOTION RULES:**

11. Must have a valid ID and a River Spirit Casino Players Card to claim all prizes.
12. Players must be 21 or older to participate. River Spirit Casino reserves the right to determine the eligibility of any contestant.
13. No employee of the River Spirit Casino or his or her significant other is eligible to participate.
14. By participating, customers allow River Spirit Casino to use their name and likeness for promotional purposes without additional compensation.
15. All decisions made by River Spirit Casino are final and binding.
16. River Spirit Casino reserves the right to change, alter, or cancel the promotion without notification.
17. Management reserves the right to change the eligible jackpot hand. Notice will be provided and be posted conspicuously in the poker room.
18. All prizes are non-transferable, void where prohibited by law. No substitutions for any prizes will be allowed unless authorized by management. In the event a winner chooses not to accept a prize, they forfeit any and all claims to the prize, which then can be awarded to another contestant at the discretion of River Spirit Casino.
19. Winners are responsible for all applicable taxes.
20. Any violation of the above contest rules or addendum will constitute disqualification and prizes will not be awarded by River Spirit Casino, their agencies, sponsors, or representatives.
21. Title 31 regulations apply to all prizes won.
22. By entering, parties agree to the above rules and decisions of the River Spirit Casino management.
